Faith Community Nursing...Karen Kline

Pastor Farmer recently signed an agreement with the BayCare Health System for Karen Kline RN, BSN to represent Grace Methodist Church as part of their Faith Community. In 2013 Karen completed a thirty-six hour course in "Foundations of Faith Community Nursing" and has been practicing in that role since.

A Faith Community Nurse (FCN) is a Nursing Specialty with its own scope and standards of practice. To become a FCN you must be a licensed Registered Nurse who practices wholistic health for self, individuals and community using nursing knowledge combined with spiritual care.

The role of a FCN combines nursing practice within a parish or faith community and serves as an advocate, educator, referral agent and volunteer facilitator and coordinator.
